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PART II

Narrative Summary

The Second Battalion, Thirteenth Marines continued artillery support of units in the DaNang area during this reporting period.. On 6 August Lt. Col. R. J. Phillips was relieved by Major W. F. Dunn as Commanding Officer. 13 August marked the beginning of a two week ARVN Section Chief training school. Two 155mm howitzers (towed) were chopped to 4/11 on 15 August.

During this period Battery E was attacked by mortars on 23 August; Battery F received 14 82mm mortar rounds outside its perimeter on 24 August; and Headquarters battery took 5 140mm rockets outside the perimeter on 26 August. The battalion fired counter rocket fires on 23, 26, 27, 30, and 31 August.

In preparation for the redeployment of RLT 27 and HLT 1/27, Battery F 2/13 was relieved by Battery A 1/11 on 26 August and Battery E 2/13 was relieved by Battery B 1/11 on 28 August. Battery D 2/13 and Mortar Battery 2/13 became OPCON to HLT 1/27 at 1200 on 28 August, and the Second Battalion, Thirteenth Marines (-) became OPCON to RLT 27 (-) upon its activation at 1200 28 August. At 1200 31 August 2/13 was relieved by 1/11. During the reporting period the Battalion accounted for 232 enemy KIA.
